## Summary

The strength of this network is enhanced by Regional Ambassadors who serve a vital role in helping the Office of Alumni & Family Engagement. Regional Ambassadors are a resource to fellow alumni in their region, acting as a liaison between alumni and the College and advocating for Wooster. Larger markets may call for multiple Regional Ambassadors to effectively engage local alumni.

# **Role Description**

- Function as a primary contact(s) in your region for the Office of Alumni & Family Engagement.
- Propose programming ideas and suggest venues for upcoming events.
- Keep young alumni (graduates of the last decade) engaged and connected.
- Encourage regional alumni to attend College events by reaching out via email or phone. Lead by example and attend as many events in your region as possible.
- Host at least one event in your area (note: multiple alumni can collaborate to host events) during your term. To start, we suggest that you take the lead in hosting an I.S. Monday Happy Hour in your city!
- Support the diversity, equity, and inclusion initiatives of the College.
