


POST-TRAUMATIC GROWTH (PTG) THEORY

<u>Definition</u>: **Positive psychological changes** that can occur when struggling w/ challenging life events (Tedeschi & Calhoun, 2004).



Sexual violence survivors \rightarrow deeper empathy & newfound passion for advocacy work (Tedeschi, 1999; Unutkan et al., 2024).

POST-TRAUMATIC GROWTH (PTG) THEORY



BACKGROUND

Why ---- & ----?

- India: ↑ rape (~90 daily in 2022) (NCRB, 2022) & rich religious diversity.
- **U.S.**: Diverse population; women of color ↑ sexual violence, e.g., 48% Mixed-race vs. 28.1% White women experienced rape (Basile et al., 2022).

Self-compassion:

- Promotes PTG via positive reframing & meaning-finding (Wong & Yeung, 2017).
- Counters harmful cognitive patterns w/kindness & self-understanding (Neff, 2003; Wu, 2024).



BACKGROUND

Activism:

- Meaning-finding & channeling pain → purpose-driven action (Guggisberg et al., 2021).
- Channels self-compassion into actions that promote growth (Fields et al., 2020).



Spirituality:

- Source of strength, new perspectives, & deepen connections—integral parts of PTG (Mushonga et al., 2021).
 - Skalski-
- Framework for self-compassion: Kindness ↓ shame & guilt → positive change (Skalski-Bednarz & Toussaint, 2024).

CURRENT STUDY

Research Questions:

RQ1 & 2: Diff. b/w survivors in India & the U.S. (1) as well as between South Asian & Black survivors (2) in terms of self-compassion, activism, spirituality, & PTG?

RQ3: Diff. b/w the age (childhood, adolescence, adulthood) at which a survivor experiences sexual violence & their amount of PTG?






Hypotheses:


H1: Survivors that have 个 self-compassion will have 个 PTG.

H2: Survivors that have \uparrow activism (2a) & \uparrow spirituality (2b) will have \uparrow PTG.

H3 & 4: Activism (3) & spirituality (4) will positively mediate the link b/w self-compassion & PTG.



Participants



N = 131 sexual violence survivors of color, M_{age} = 35.76 n = 72 Indian M_{age} = 32.85 & n = 59 American, M_{age} = 39.31





 Participants were recruited via Cloud Research where they completed an online survey on self-compassion, anti-sexual violence activism, spirituality, & PTG.





Means in Indian and United States Residents for Study Variables




Means in Black/African Americans and South Asians for Study Variables



One-way ANOVA





DISCUSSION

Diff. in activism possibly reflect sociocultural diff.

• Consistency in self-compassion, spirituality, & PTG amounts suggests their universality.

Adolescents \(\gamma\) developed cognitive abilities.

Positive changes → 2 weeks after assault for mostly White women (Frazier et al., 2001).

Cognitive processes in self-compassion & spirituality maybe self-focused.

IMPLICATIONS

Advocacy therapy + Racial justice (Roberts, 2023).

Self-compassion & spirituality interventions ↑ PTG across races. Childhood survivors \rightarrow structured meaning-making therapy.

Policy recommendations

Organizations \rightarrow address intersectional barriers to advocacy
