

## 2026-2027 Federal Verification of Student Identity – To Be Signed with a Notary

Your 2026-2027 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was processed by the FAFSA Processing System (FPS) and selected for the Federal Verification review process that requires the Financial Aid Office to verify the student's identity.

If the student is unable to verify their identity by appearing in person at The College of Wooster, the student must:

- Sign the Statement of Identity (below) in the presence of a public notary.
- Provide the notary with the valid government-issued photo identification (ID) that is acknowledged in the notary statement below, such as, but not limited to a driver's license, other state-issued ID, or passport.
- Submit the original notarized form and a copy of the identification presented to the notary, to the Financial Aid Office.
